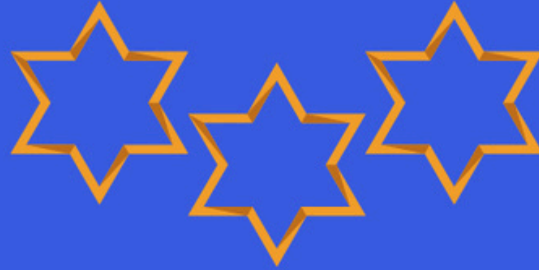

Keeping Jewish Students Safe

We are increasingly concerned by the rise in antisemitism. The recent violent attack on Temple Israel in Michigan is yet another reminder that Jewish communities continue to face real threats.

Of particular concern is the growing hostility toward Jewish students on campuses across the United States, including here in Florida. Reports of harassment, exclusion, vandalism, and intimidation have increased -often tied to tensions surrounding the Middle East.

While open dialogue and debate are essential to a healthy democracy, they must never cross the line into targeting students because they are Jewish or perceived to be connected to Israel.

On campuses such as the University of South Florida, University of Central Florida, Florida State University, and the University of Florida, Jewish students have shared that they feel increasingly isolated and, at times, unsafe expressing their identity.

The Suncoast Jewish Alliance remains firmly committed to protecting both civil rights and free expression-while ensuring that Jewish students can learn, live, and engage safely and without fear.

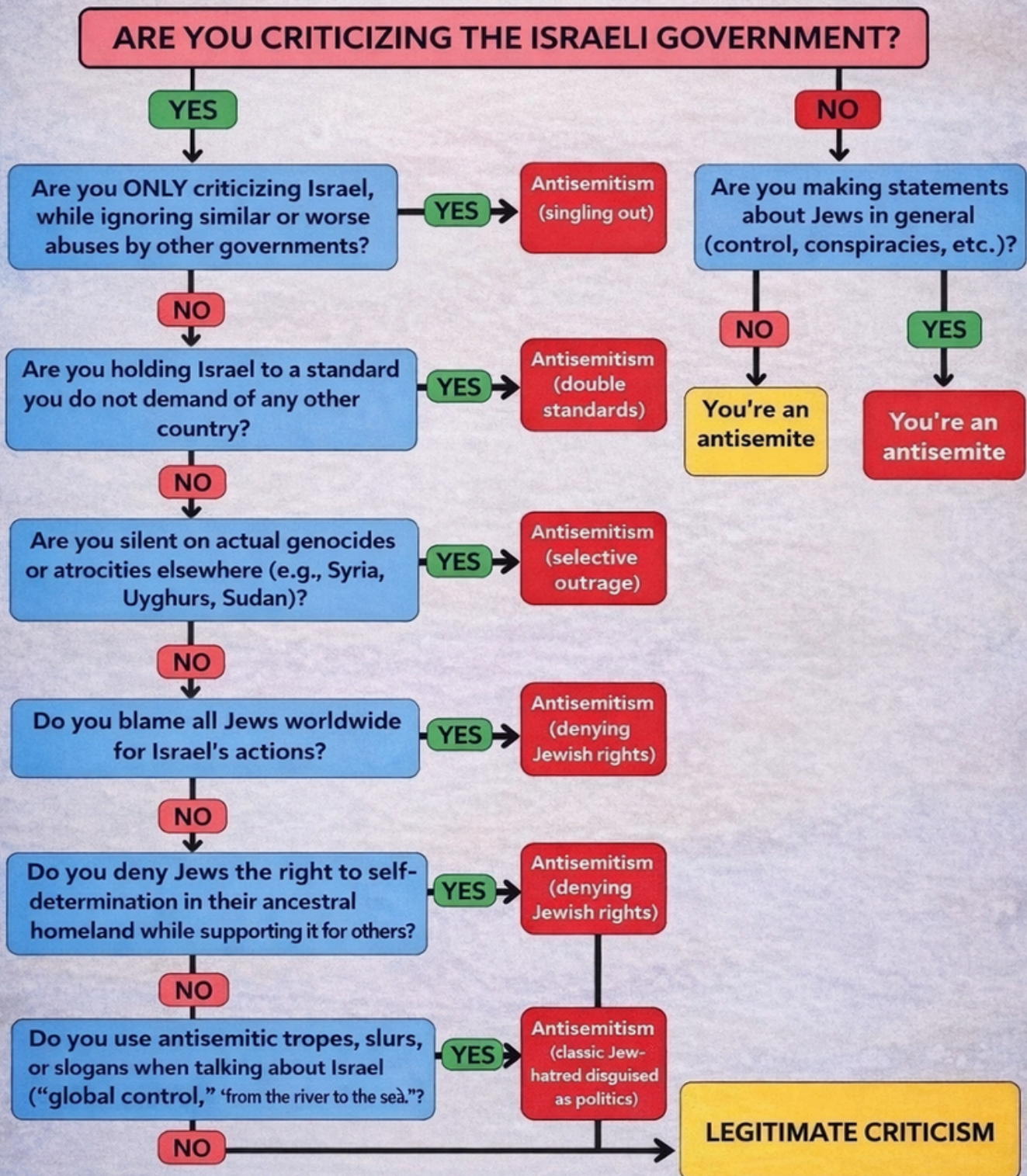
